YEOVIL CHRISTIANS AGAINST POVERTY This is an exciting opportunity to join the Debt Centre team as a paid debt coach. It's all about seeing lives transformed by sharing the love of Jesus in a relevant way and journeying with people to become debt free. You will need to work for 16 hours per week, be trained by CAP in Bradford, visit people in their homes and have the use of a car. With an active Christian faith you need to inspire people, remain emotionally strong, have good time management and administration, and be confident in using the internet and Microsoft WORD. Whilst the post is part-time salaried, it is possible that some work *may* need to be carried out in the evening, though the bulk of work is expected to be during the day. There is a Genuine Occupational Requirement that the post is filled by a Christian and application packs will be issued with a closing date for their completion and return by 10 am on Friday 13 November 2015.
