We are currently running short of:-

meals in a tin, tinned potato, tinned mince & onion, tinned ravioli, jars of pasta sauce, sugar, 80 Teabags, tins of rice pudding and savoury biscuits.

CAP Centre Manager Some of you will know by now that Ian has retired as centre manager, and that I have taken on the role temporarily. We have now selected the new Manager. His name is Steve Hart, and he is part of Yeovil Community Church. As a result, we need to increase the money that we need from £10,500 per year to £26,500 per year to account for the new salary and the associated costs.

We have asked several other churches to partner with us to raise this additional funding, and it is needed (at least to be promised) to start employing Steve. Would you therefore pray about how much you might be able to give towards this amount? Any amount as a monthly donation over the next three or more years will be really helpful, even if it is only £1 per month. I have worked out that we need the equivalent of 103 people to give £10 per month with gift aid to reach the sum we need.

There are giving forms at the back of church, and a box in which to place them. Please respond before the end of this month. Steve starts his CAP training in the first week of October. This is vital for the CAP Centre to stay open, and continue to reach over 50 new clients per year who are really struggling with unmanageable debt.

CAP Money Course Another CAP Money course has been set up. It starts on October 9th at 7.30pm in the Schoolrooms, upstairs. It is open to all. If you have never done one, why not join us and bring a friend as a pre mission event. The course is called Budget, Save, Spend, and runs for three consecutive Thursday evenings.
