Wanted: Centre Manager for the Yeovil CAP Debt Centre

We are recruiting for someone to both manage the local centre, and supervise (currently three) debt coaches. They will themselves also undertake duties as a debt coach. The candidate should be a "people person" - able to talk to clients one to one about their debt situation; be a driver with their own vehicle; a good organiser, and able to share their faith with others.

The post is salaried, part time, for three "days" per week, (£12k pa to begin with - £20k pro rata). Work may include some evenings, to suit the needs of clients; most work is during the day.
