We are recruiting for someone to both manage the local centre, and supervise (currently three) debt coaches. In addition they will themselves undertake duties as a debt coach. The candidate should be a "people person" - able to talk to clients one to one about their debt situation; to be a driver with their own vehicle; a good organiser, and able to share their faith with others.

The post is salaried, part time, for three "days" per week, (£12k pa to begin with - £20k pro rata). Some time worked may need to be in the evenings, to suit the needs of clients; generally the bulk of work is during the day.
