Christian Aid News

A big thank you to everyone who donated to Christian Aid recently, either to the Nepal Appeal, or to the Christian Aid Week house-to-house collection.

Nepal: St Andrews donated £193.50 and so far Churches in Yeovil have raised £993.50 which has been paid into the Christian Aid DEC account for Nepal. Other churches in the area may have donated directly to the DEC.

CA week House-to-House: Many thanks to Di Johnson and Les & Linda Jackson for helping with the collection. This raised £267.08.

The St John's Collection for the Nepal Earthquake Emergency Appeal (via Christian Aid) raised £382.
