### **East Africa / South Sudan Crisis Appeal.**

Since we launched this collection there has been a lot of media publicity which highlights a wider problem across East Africa, of which South Sudan is part. The Disasters Emergency Committee (which includes Christian Aid) now says at least 16 million people in Somalia, Kenya, Ethiopia and South Sudan need food, water and medical treatment and the government has said it will match the first £5m donated by the public.

There will be envelopes at the back of the church for a Christian Aid Emergency Collection for the East Africa /South Sudan Crisis Appeal.
