If there are changes to be made to an existing entry – address, telephone number, e-mail address etc, please complete and return the form.

If you consider yourself to be part of the St John’s or St Andrew’s church family and would like to be included in the directory, please complete a form.

Once printed, the directory is for the use of the church family only and is NOT kept on display.

The preparation of a new church electoral roll – full revision

Full revision of the electoral Roll for St John's and St Andrew's.
This means EVERYONE currently on our electoral roll must complete a new form, and new members can join.

Any names currently on the electoral roll will be deleted if a new form is not completed. If you consider yourself a member of St. John's or St. Andrew's, you should join the roll. A form will be available at both churches by the middle of January at which point - **URGENT ACTION REQUIRED BY ALL!**

This is totally separate from the church directory

Joining the roll, is a practical sign of commitment to the church. It allows us to take part in decisions which affect the church and parish, to take part in the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM), and to stand for the Parochial Church Council.

A completely new church electoral roll must be prepared every six years for each parish. 2019 is the year for full revision.
