Full revision of the electoral Roll for St John's and St Andrew's.

Any names currently on the electoral roll **will be deleted if a new form is not completed.** If you consider yourself a member of St. John's or St. Andrew's, you should join the roll. A 2019 form is now available at both churches so - **URGENT ACTION REQUIRED BY ALL!**

## **This is totally separate from the church directory**

Joining the roll, is a practical sign of commitment to the church. It allows us to take part in decisions which affect the church and parish, to take part in the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM), and to stand for the Parochial Church Council.

A completely new church electoral roll must be prepared every six years for each parish. 2019 is the year for full revision.
