If there are changes to be made to an existing entry – address, telephone number, e-mail address etc, please complete and return the form.

If you consider yourself to be part of the St John's or St Andrew's church family and would like to be included in the directory, please complete a form and return it before the end of January.

Thank you! Once printed, the directory is for the use of the church family only, and is NOT kept on display.

The preparation of a new church electoral roll is an opportunity to encourage those new to church life, or to the community, to join the roll, as a practical sign of commitment to the church. It allows us to take part in decisions which affect the church and parish, to take part in the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM), and to stand for the Parochial Church Council.

Every six years, a completely new church electoral roll must be prepared for each parish. A new roll is due to be prepared this year

URGENT ACTION REQUIRED BY ALL!

Full revision of the electoral Roll for St John's and St Andrew's.

This means EVERYONE currently on our electoral roll must complete a new form, and new members can join.

Any names currently on the electoral roll will be deleted if a new form is not completed. If you consider yourself a member of St. John's or St. Andrew's, you should join the roll. A form will be available at both churches by the middle of January.
